Safe Food & Food Poisoning	Staff + Pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hands must be washed and blue gloves must be worn before serving food. Groups must be advised to ensure all hands are washed prior to the BBQ. All foods are precooked in the kitchen to ensure safe preparation. Food to be served with appropriate implements. Food temperatures to be taken in the Kitchen & at the BBQ before served to staff & pupils. All food temperatures to be recorded on the correct sheets. All food waste to be disposed of immediately after the activity. All food items to be transported in the yellow plastic wheelbarrow. The yellow wheelbarrow will be washed with an anti bac spray before and after the BBQ. Any foods needed for dietary needs to be kept separate and served with clean sterile implements. 	L
Low Light	Staff + Pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Torch's to be provided by New Barn for all staff in low light conditions. Pupils to walk safely in small groups to and from the Nev's Nook using torches if required. 	L
Burn Injuries	Staff + Pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group will be briefed at the start of the session to keep clear of the campfire. Camp fires to remain small and always in control. Fire & BBQ tended only by New Barn staff, no one else is to add wood or throw things into the fire. 	L

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All pupils to remain seated and at a sensible distance from the camp fire & BBQ.• Pupils will walk in small groups around the fire and into the building at Nev's Nook and be given their hot food.• Constant reminders are given to be aware of the fire.• Wood is carefully chosen by MCD to produce a non - fume fire with minimal spitting.• If pupils need to move they are instructed to go around the outside of the ring of seats.• Any 'presentations' etc are to be made either seated or on the stage outside the earth house.
