Monitor coach movements, supervise and assist where appropriate. Groups to be instructed on arrival that the car park area should be avoided and for younger groups out of bounds. During Orienteering a member of staff will be situated in the car park area. The area is monitored and maintained to a good safe level. The gravel surface is kept level and even, with any debris removed immediately. 	L
