During free time, such as breaks for lunch, supervision is the responsibility of group staff.

All pupils wash their hands thoroughly after touching animals or taking part in activities and before eating or drinking. Pupils should not place their faces against any animal. No animal feed should be tasted or eaten. There is to be full supervision of group by accompanying adults. Pupils are not to enter fields with animals, only on individually. assessed occasions when New Barn staff judge it is safe. No tractors or machinery of any kind should be ridden on or played with. 	L
Lost Pupil	Pupils & Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Access will be restricted to a designated area of the site, such as the Coffee Shop, Town Hall, Play Area, or an area of grass near the office or car park. All groups will be given a meeting point in case of separation. 	L

Fire Safety	Pupils & Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lead adults will sign the group onto the centre and basic fire procedures will be explained to the whole group. All day groups will be given and shown a fire assembly point. 	L
